Purpose Population Foundation of India will implement a three project to increase the adoption and use of family planning (FP) and sexual reproductive health (SRH) through responsive and sustainable systems in seven districts of Uttar Pradesh (Bahraich, Balrampur, Barabanki, Gonda, Sitapur, Unnao and Shravasti). Each district will have a two-member team comprising a Government Partnership Officer (GPO) and a CBO. The position will be responsible for leading all capacity building efforts in one of the assigned districts.
