- Develop and regularly maintain quality process documentation for all PFI projects and activities being implemented in the state
- Anchor the development of bi-annual newsletter under PFI's Umeed project and ensure its widespread dissemination
- Ensure all organizational documents like project proposals, budgets, training modules, training reports, meetings & events-based documentation, SBCC materials & modules, monthly, quarterly, annual progress reports & other relevant documents are accurate, up-to-date, and properly archived.
- Ensure all photographs and audio video documentation is maintained, regularly updated and archived for easy access
